If some of them were bad or defective, the battery might SHOW full charge, or show even a partial charge, but it won't be accurate. As soon as you really just drain the good cells, the unit turns off. You must log in to answer this question.

Why does my laptop battery take so long to charge?

If you keep external devices such as a smartphone, a USB external drive, mouse, printer and anything else attached to your system while charging, it will take longer for your battery to reach 100%. Make sure you disconnect all of those devices so your system won't be competing with all the other electronics. 6.

How do I check battery capacity?

It does happen. Try checking Battery Report, -> Open cmd in Administrator mode -> Enter 'powercfg/batteryreport' -> Go to saved location 'C:\Windows\system32\battery-report.html' &open it. -> Check Installed Battery 'DESIGN CAPACITY' &'FULL CHARGE CAPACITY'.
