

Can I charge the battery if the panel is removed

Why is my solar panel not charging my battery?

Your solar panel should have easily kept your battery fully topped up regardless of alarm usage. Mine is full in storage and reliant on the solar panels. therefore I would deduce that either there is a fault with the solar charging system or the battery has failed. Suggest you try to recharge the battery, a smart charger would be best I believe.

Can a solar panel keep my battery topped up?

Do I need to remove a battery when replacing a solar panel?

I think in the future though, I will have to when the battery needs replacing. Plenty of time to contact Truma for advice though before that happens. Batteries only 9 months old. Simply cover the solar panel. If you are replacing the battery (no light no leccy) but no need to remove battery.

What happens if a battery is not fully charged?

1) If your large battery is not fully charged, all the dinky panel without controller will do is slow down the self-discharge. It is too small to actually charge it to any reasonable degree, although it may attain a devilishly foolish "surface charge". So people think they can get away with no controller especially if it isn't stored long term.

Should a solar panel be fused before disconnecting a battery?

Disconnect solar panel (eg pull fuse) before disconnecting battery. On your controller check that fuse is actually solar panel one, could be for battery. Ideally all 3 circuits should be fused: solar in, battery, load out. I was a bit surprised by a recent comment when having an annual service, including review of the electrical systems.

Do I need to remove a battery from a Truma solar panel?

Plenty of time to contact Truma for advice though before that happens. Batteries only 9 months old. Simply cover the solar panel. If you are replacing the battery (no light no leccy) but no need to remove battery. The solar panel and controller does a superb job of this.

Check the instructions for the panel controller - they usually recommend a sequence for connecting the battery & panel and a corresponding one for disconnecting it.

Solar can be a bit of a minefield, but if you have a panel already installed, have a look at the controller (ideally post up a pic") as some have the ability to charge more than 1 battery. Some of the latest MPPT controllers will have 2 outputs, 1 for Leisure 1 for Vehicle

A battery maintainer, on the other hand, allows you to charge the battery without removal, but may not offer as deep a charge as a full battery out of the vehicle. The positive aspect of removing the battery for charging is the potential for a thorough recharge.
