

Can the lithium battery still be used if the plug cable is broken

What happens if a lithium battery is broken?

Broken or cracked cases can allow moisture and oxygen to enter the battery and oxidize the lithium components, causing a heat reaction also known as thermal runaway. This can lead to fires or explosions. Overheating, overcharging and shock from dropping or crushing can also cause heat reactions to occur.

How to repair a lithium ion battery?

It depends on the cause (of battery failure). If the battery is not physically damaged, or not moisture infected, and hasn't aged excessively, the lithium-ion battery can be restored using several techniques like slow charging, parallel charging, using a battery repair device etcetera.
