Many countries permit marks to cover an entire class without regard to specific descriptions of goods or services. There is a general classification of marks into trademarks, service marks, certification marks and collective marks, each of which have slightly different rules.

There are exceptions to every rule, but, in general: if a trademark is in a different line of business or a different channel of trade, even if it is identical to a pre-existing trademark, they can both be registered. ... and purses.
