How do I charge my notebook PC?

How often should I charge my laptop battery?

What is the capacity of a notebook battery?

The typical notebook battery has between 2,000 and 6,000 milliamp hours of capacity. This is the conductive part of the battery to which electrons flow. Also known as NiCd, this is the original battery technology used in notebooks.

I have an HP laptop that does not like its new after-market battery (original parts are no longer in production). I am having a curious problem in that when the battery finishes charging, that if the AC adapter lost power, the computer will shut down immediately. However if the power connector is pulled out of the laptop itself, it doesn't.
