

How to replace the battery in the fire protection system

Do you need to replace a fire alarm battery?

When a hard-wired fire alarm beeps, you must replace its battery. This Home article offers instructions for replacing a fire alarm's battery and turning off a fire alarm, including which skills you'll need to do so. If you hear a low-battery alarm beep or chirp, do not ignore it and do not take the battery out without replacing it.

How often should you change a fire alarm battery?

Unless you have a 10-year alarm, change the battery once a year, possibly when the clocks go forward in spring or back in autumn. If you have the latter, you should replace the complete device every ten years. This might create the question "how to change a fire alarm battery", keep reading for more information.

How do you change a fire alarm battery?

The first step to changing your fire alarm battery is to remove the cover. With a little twisting motion, pry open or unclip the cover of the detector from its base. The sensing chamber, loud horn, and battery are all housed within. 2. Replace the Battery Remove the old battery from its holder.

How to install a fire alarm battery?

Make sure to check the type and size of the battery required for your specific fire alarm model and purchase the correct one. In most cases, the fire alarm will be mounted on the ceiling or high up on a wall. A stable ladder will be necessary to reach and safely remove the old battery and install the new one.

Should I use a rechargeable battery for a fire alarm?

A: It is generally recommended to use non-rechargeable batteries for fire alarms as they have a longer lifespan and maintain their charge better in case of a power outage. However, if you choose to use rechargeable batteries, make sure to replace them more frequently and test their voltage regularly.

How do you remove a fire alarm battery?

Carefully climb the ladder and reach the fire alarm. Depending on the model, you may need to twist or unscrew the alarm's cover to access the battery compartment. Once open, identify the old battery. Gently remove it by either sliding it out or disconnecting the attached terminals.
