Why is my battery making a noise?

Buzzing with 35W Power Adapter The 35W Dual USB-C Port Power Adapter that came with my M2 MacBook Air makes a buzzing sound every time it is plugged in and charging any device. I've used the MagSafe 3 cord, another USB-C to USB-C cord but it still buzzes when it is charging only 1 device.
